Fishguard Port is part of a quaint town on the rocky tip of beautiful Pembrokeshire, making it an ideal place to start your West Wales adventure.

# Our services and facilities

The port has a tender berth that allows larger cruise ships to moor within the port and a sheltered alongside berth for expedition size cruise vessels.

Disembarking passengers are treated to a Welsh welcome from the port team, local dignitaries and locals performing a traditional song and dance.

Coaches are provided at the quayside for onward tours and excursions, while toilet facilities and refreshment machines are available on the quayside railway concourse.

The port is flanked by headlands of Pembrokeshire Coast National Park. We work closely with wildlife groups to protect the environment as there are often harbour porpoises and dolphin sightings in the bay.

### Additional capabilities

We provide berthing and handling facilities for ferry traffic, principally between Rosslare (Ireland) and Fishguard. Vessels include regular scheduled passenger and vehicle ferries. The port's primary commercial vessel movement is ferry traffic, but occasional calls are made by smaller commercial ships, military support vessels and fishing craft.

### Security

Fishguard Port has 4 berths. Berths 1, 2 and 3 are available for commercial and cruise ship use and are ISPS approved when required. Berth 4 is for Stena Line Ferry use and is permanently ISPS approved. The port is fully covered by digital CCTV and security personnel.



Fishguard Port is located in north Pembrokeshire, with road connections to the M4 motorway via the A40 and A48. Rail services run from the station located in the harbour, providing links with seagoing transport. There are daily services to and from Fishguard Harbour that coincide with ferry services to Rosslare in Ireland.
