# Our services and facilities

An anchorage in the UK's largest energy port makes for an interesting stop off; you see natural beauty and wildlife juxtaposed by industry. Tenders take just minutes to arrive at Mackerel Quay, where a warm Welsh welcome awaits passengers.

There are walks and vistas from the cruise terminal to the harbour. Milford Waterfront and the town centre have a fantastic selection of places to eat and shops for local gifts and mementos.

Milford Haven is in the centre of Pembrokeshire, with popular excursion destinations including St Davids and Tenby under 45 minutes away. It has great links by rail and bus for those wishing to head further into Wales.

**Additional capabilities**  
A call at Milford Haven involves anchoring off Milford Shelf in the natural deep-water harbour. Pilotage is compulsory and tugs are also required for all calls at anchor off Milford Haven. Tugs must be arranged and paid for by the vessel. Cruise call quayside services include visitor information and local shuttle buses to the town and entertainment.

**Security**  
Security at all of the cruise facilities within the Port of Milford Haven complies with the ISPS code at all levels. A full search service can be provided if required. All shoreside facilities are covered by digitally recorded CCTV systems.



The town of Milford Haven is on the north side of the Milford Haven Waterway. It has road connections to the M4 motorway via the A4076, A40 and A48.
