Additional capabilities
The port is able to support transit and turnaround operations with berth capacity for check-in facilities, baggage handling, security screening and on-site car parking. Adjacent gangway coach parking is available for passengers with restricted mobility. The port can arrange shuttle buses for passengers wanting to go towards Swansea Bay or the city centre.
